NESLL Boys Spring League – Town Select Division

Last Spring, recognizing the changing landscape of New England lacrosse, we have determined that we would open up NESLL to town select teams. The initial year was a tremendous success! All of the teams that entered enjoyed the level of competition, the league structure and the organization. In 2012 we look to expand the division adding more town programs and providing two tiers of play.

New England Select Lacrosse League – “Select Division”

Members of the “Select Division” will be comprised of “Town Select” teams from around the region as well as regional NESLL – “Select” teams.

The league will be divided into age groups – U15 and U13, each age group will be divided into levels based on program size and strength.

NESLL will provide:

- All referee scheduling and payments. Two certified referees will be used for ALL games.
- Eight game regular season plus the NESLL Play-off Day.
- League scheduling, communication, results and standings.
- Play-off Day - facility, referees, etc.
- Town Select “All-Star” Game.
- Discounted Winter Clinics – schedule to be released in early September.
- Coaching clinics for member towns.
 - One FREE regional coaching clinic to introduce coaching philosophies, game strategies, and practice planning.
 - Discounted price on town coaches training – program to be released in September.
- Discounted apparel packages on co-branded NESLL/town merchandise.
- Summer Tournament Opportunity for top players.

Town Programs will provide:

- All practice fields, coaches, uniforms, misc. equipment, etc.
- Game fields

League Details –

- Age Groups – “Select Division”
 - U15's (7th & 8th Grade)
 - U13's (5th & 6th Grade)
- League play begins Saturday, March 31st.
- Games will be played on Saturdays (with the possibility of some mid-week make-up games, if necessary).
- **NO** games will be played on Sundays as we will continue to support MBYLL.
- Games will be 4 x 12 minute, stop-time periods.
- Two referees will be used for all games.
- NCAA rules will be used (some modifications will be made).
- Play-off Day will be held on Saturday, June 2nd

 - Directions page – including fields for all participating teams
 - Team contact information
 - Weekly news from the lacrosse world – high school, college, etc.
